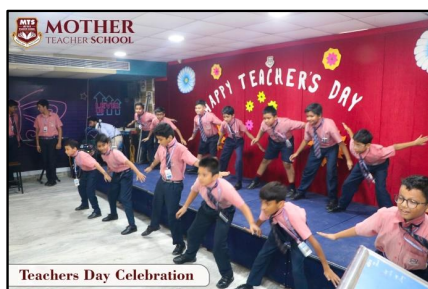
MTS TEACHERS' DAY 'TOUR'

Parent Teacher Meeting is a great opportunity to know and to work for perfection and modification of students' performance and to

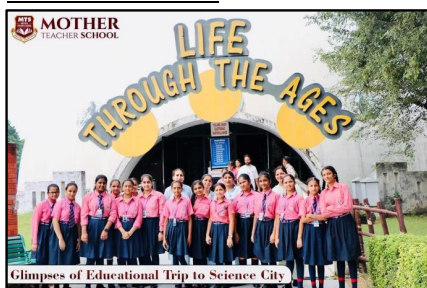
