CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATION 14th November 2023 Classes- PLAYSCHOOL-II



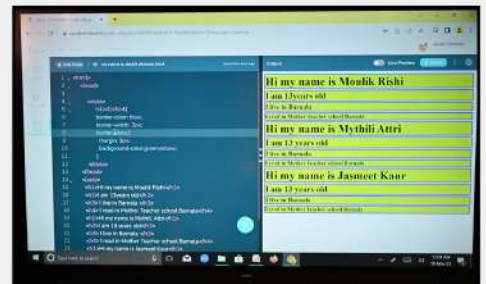
