

ANNUAL REPORT 2024-25

G. Holy Heart Public School (GHHPS), affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi, is managed by the Lala Hardial Education Society. Nestled on the outskirts of Mehal Kalan, the school boasts a sprawling campus equipped with ultra-modern facilities. The rich legacy of the institution continues to speak for itself.

The session 2024-25 commenced with the serene recitation of *Sri Sukhmani Sahib Path* and prayers, invoking divine blessings for the year ahead. The collective efforts of the staff and management were reflected in encouraging admissions. The new session began on a joyful note as Nursery students penned down their thoughts on their very first day at school.

At GHHPS, education is imparted through a balanced blend of academics, co-curriculars, values, and skills, ensuring the 360-degree development of every child.

Academic Excellence

Academics continue to be our priority. Remedial classes were initiated for slow learners, while competitive examinations and Olympiads exposed students to global standards. Around 800 students participated in Olympiads and inter-school competitions. With a **100% Board result in Classes X and 93% result in Class XII**, the school once again stood tall. Nearly 10 students from Class XII and more than 13 students from Class X secured above 90% marks. Truly, GHHPS continues to be a **flagbearer of excellence**.

Value Education & Wellness

The school strongly believes in inculcating values alongside knowledge. Workshops on **21st Century Skills, Value Education, Mental and Physical Wellness** were conducted. A **Mega Medical Camp** was organized for eye, dental, and physical checkups. Students were sensitized to adolescence-related challenges through counselling sessions, while **Boys' and Girls' Welfare Committees** emphasized issues like *Good Touch–Bad Touch* and the importance of a “Safe Circle.” Career counselling sessions were also held to guide students towards informed choices.

School–Parent Partnership

The role of parents in shaping children cannot be overstated. To strengthen this partnership, the school organized several **interactive parenting sessions** on topics like *Good Parenting Traits, Handling Adolescence, and Parents' Role during Exams*. Eight **Parent–Teacher Meetings (PTMs)** were conducted during the session, enabling constructive dialogue between teachers and parents for the holistic growth of students.

Co-curricular Activities

To nurture creativity and talent, students were engaged in a wide range of co-curricular activities under four houses – **Charity, Peace, Courage, and Wisdom**. Competitions included **mental ability tests, calligraphy, creative writing, world heritage quiz, poster making, best out of waste, rangoli, patriotic songs, debates, declamations, spell bee, and slogan writing**, to name a few.

Festivals and important days such as **Baisakhi, Lohri, Diwali, Earth Day, Rashtriya Ekta Diwas, Kargil Vijay Diwas, Shiksha Saptah, and Swachhta Pakhwada** were celebrated with enthusiasm. The school also hosted the event “*Nikian Zindaan, Wadde Saake*”, highlighting the supreme sacrifices of Guru Sahib’s four Sahibzade. Students also actively participated in district-level celebrations of national festivals. On Diwali, essential items were donated to the underprivileged in Barnala, instilling the value of service.

Excursions & Educational Visits

Tours and excursions added joy and exposure to learning. Students visited **Hardy’s World, Ludhiana** and **Manali**, while younger ones went on short trips to **Gurdwara Mehtiana Sahib**. An in-house picnic for pre-primary classes was also arranged. Students participated in plantation drives, **zero-plastic awareness campaigns**, and educational visits to forts and heritage sites in and around Barnala. An exhibition showcasing students’ creativity further enriched their learning experience.

Teacher Training & Capacity Building

Delivering quality education requires empowered teachers. The school conducted several **Capacity Building Programs** in collaboration with the CBSE Centre of Excellence and other agencies. Teachers completed more than **50 hours of training**, covering areas such as **Assessment, Stress Management, Classroom Management, Bloom’s Taxonomy, and Gender Equality**. Both online and offline modes were effectively utilized.

Sports Achievements

Sports form an integral part of GHPS. The **Sports Club** witnessed massive participation, with **300+ students competing at the district level and over 50 at the state level**. The school bagged **first position in District Level Football (U-19)**, while **Manveer Kaur** brought laurels by being selected for the **National U-19 Cricket Team**. Students also excelled in games like **Basketball, Skating, Athletics, Table Tennis, Badminton, and Karate**.

Infrastructure & Facilities

Spread across **26,683.96 sq. meters**, GHHPS offers one of the finest infrastructures in Mehal Kalan and its surroundings. The campus is fully air-conditioned and houses **two computer labs, science labs, an English language lab, and a well-stocked library**. Spacious playgrounds include dedicated **football, basketball, and cricket grounds**. The school's transport fleet is fully equipped with **GPS and CCTV cameras**, ensuring safety and efficiency.
