attention was captured by the talent show, the welcome song, and the inspirational audio.



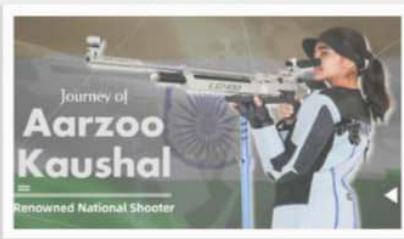
