Academic Highlights:

The CBSE Board results for the session 2022-23 of classes 10th and 12th were 100%.

In Class X, out of 156 students, 20 students scored 90% & above with the highest score of 97.2%.

In Class XII, out of 152 students, students scored 90% & above with the highest score of 94% in Commerce; 93.6% in Medical; 96.4% in Non- medical.

Achievements & Awards:
